Terms and Conditions

Public Private Partnership (PPP) Competition 2011

1. Eligible Companies

- 1.1. GIZ is partnering with Ugandan and multinational companies, which are
 - 1.1.1. Legally registered.
 - 1.1.2. in business for at least two years.
 - 1.1.3. members of UMA or are in the process of becoming a member of UMA
 - 1.1.4. Interested to address social and/or environmental issues.
- 1.2. Competitive neutrality is guaranteed. All companies are eligible to cooperate with GIZ. All communication is transparent.
- 1.3. The private sector is an equal partner, not the main beneficiary of PPP projects. The PPP programme targets private companies, which are financially and structurally able to implement the project through completion.
- 1.4. The PPP programme does not address business starters (founded less than 2 years) and enterprises which are economically unstable or only interested in short term involvement.

2. Eligible Projects

- 2.1. The intended project shall benefit the partner company, and must contribute to a measurable and lasting development benefit.
- 2.2. Every PPP project has to be in line with the focal areas of the German International Cooperation in Uganda, which are:
 - 2.2.1. Finance Sector Development,
 - 2.2.2. Vocational training,
 - 2.2.3. Health Service
- 2.3. Public support to the project is only given, if the private partner would not otherwise implement the PPP measure and if the PPP project is not a legal necessity
- 2.4. The private sector partner has to contribute at least 50% of the total project costs
- 2.5. The project shall be completed within a reasonable time (1 year)
- 2.6. The project is economically, socially and environmentally sustainable in the long-run and the project has no negative impacts.
- 2.7. The project shall be aware of and supported by the company top management.

3. Services offered by GIZ

- 3.1. GIZ offers financial assistance in form of a grant for selected projects.
- 3.2. Each winning projects receive between 5,000.000 UGX – 20,000.000 UGX, which covers maximum of 50 % of the total project costs.
- 3.3. The financial assistance by GIZ must be spent and accounted for by December 15th 2011
- 3.4. Only funds directly related to the implementation of the project can be contributed to the joint project. The following costs cannot be included in the specification of project costs:
 - 3.4.1. project development, feasibility studies
 - 3.4.2. tax burdens
 - 3.4.3. purchase of real estate or property
 - 3.4.4. general investment (e.g. investments in office)
 - 3.4.5. recurring salary, which cannot be directly described to the project
 - 3.4.6. costs arising from the fulfilment of legal requirements (e.g. Labour Law)
 - 3.4.7. running, operation and maintenance of own buildings and machines
 - 3.4.8. Costs or expenditures having arisen or arising for the company from activities previously conducted or initiated
